2013 Work Programmes of the 7th Research Framework Programme
9 June 2012 (10-07, 17h30)

The Representation of the European Commission in Portugal, in collaboration with the Foundation for Science and Technology, has organized a presentation about the FP7 on 9 July at 09h30, directed to the press and interested parties.

80 participants were welcomed by the acting Head of the Representation, Luiz Sá Pessoa and the President of the Foundation for Science and Technology, Miguel Seabra. Then Professor Eduardo Maldonado, Coordinator of the National Contact Point for FP7, discussed the national dimension. After the coffee break, two success stories were discussed. Professor Nazlin Howell of the University of Surrey and Maria Leonor Nunes from IPIMAR talked about their SECUREFISH project and Jocelyne Demengeot from the Gulbenkian Science Institute talked about the NAIMIT project. The 2013 Work Programmes of the 7th Research Framework Programme was presented by Mario Campolargo, Director of DG CONNECT from the European Commission. The session ended at 13.00 with questions from the participants.

According to the daily OJE, the European Commission announced the biggest package ever of promotion in the research and innovation sectors. The package contains €8.1 billion to support programs that might contribute to the growth and employment pact. The majority of the proposals are going to be presented today with the rest in October. The scope of the proposals is human health, environmental protection and new solutions for urbanization and waste collection.
